At-home COVID-19 tests covered by your pharmacy benefit

Beginning January 15, 2022, members of the Adventist Health Employee Health Plan will be able to obtain FDA/EUA approved over-the-counter COVID-19 tests at no cost at in-network pharmacies.

- Your OptumRx pharmacy benefit will cover up to eight FDA/EUA approved over-the-counter COVID-19 tests per covered plan member per month, purchased without a provider's order or prescription.
- To be covered at no cost by your pharmacy benefit, at-home COVID-19 tests must be obtained at the pharmacy counter with your health plan member ID card on or after January 15, 2022, at an in-network pharmacy (in-house, community partner or OptumRx retail pharmacies or home delivery).
- At-home COVID-19 tests purchased at a non-participating pharmacy or retailer (or the retail counter at a participating pharmacy) on or after January 15, 2022, will need to be paid for upfront. Be sure to save all receipts and submit a direct reimbursement form to OptumRx once more information about this claim process is available. Tests purchased at non-participating pharmacies or retailers (or the retail counter at a participating pharmacy) will be reimbursed in full until adequate access to free tests at in-network pharmacies and via mail order has been established, at which point tests will be reimbursed at a maximum of \$12 per test.
- Tests purchased for employment purposes do not qualify for coverage.
